Membership Card and Bag Tag

Your annual bag tag should be affixed to your golf bag as this helps to identify our members on the course. Accident & Emergency Procedures

In the event of an accident, first aid boxes are located in the Golf Receptions and the Driving Range. A Defibrillator is available at the Thorpe Wood Driving Range and Orton Meadows Reception. Thorpe Wood: 01733 267701 Orton Meadows: 01733 237478. Accidents and incidents MUST be reported to the Golf Reception immediately so that appropriate action may be taken by trained members and staff and documentation completed.

Safety on the Courses

Members and visitors should always determine whether they consider the course safe to play for their own abilities and situation. Players have a duty of care to behave in such a way that others may not be injured by their actions. They also have a duty of care to ensure that they do not injure themselves. All players play at their own risk and should do nothing to jeopardise the safety of themselves or others. If the Course Manager deems the courses unplayable you must obey this notice.

On Course Guidelines

- Please play quickly, quietly and courteously.
- Do not stand close to other players when they are swinging the club
- Always stand behind a player taking the shot
- Do not play until the gap in front is clear
- Shout "fore" if you feel your ball is heading towards other players
