IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Welcome Pack and Bag Tag

All 5-day and 7-day members will receive an annual tag in your Welcome Pack which will be ready to collect from the Thorpe Wood Starter Hut once your payment has been received (please allow 3 working days).

Your annual bag tag should be affixed to your golf bag as this helps to identify our members on the course.

All Nene Golf Members will also find in their Welcome Pack a car park pass for Thorpe Wood please affix this to your car window.

Finally you will also receive a Membership Card with important accident and emergency information, a QR code to Member information and our important contact details. We advise you keep this on your person whilst you are visiting a Nene Golf site.

Dress Code

While we do not have a strict dress code policy, we would encourage our members and visitors to avoid garments displaying slogans, sports vests, singlets, football shirts or clothing which is not neat and tidy.

Accident & Emergency Procedures

In the event of an accident, first aid boxes are located in both Golf Receptions and the Driving Range. A Defibrillator is available at the Thorpe Wood Driving Range and Orton Meadows Reception. Accidents and incidents **MUST** be reported to the Golf Reception immediately so that appropriate action may be taken by trained members and staff and documentation completed.

Emergency services: 999 (Orton Meadows: PE2 5UU Thorpe Wood: PE3 6SE). Please refer to your Membership card (found in your Welcome Pack for What 3 Words location details).

Safety on the Courses

Members and visitors should always determine whether they consider the course safe to play for their own abilities and situation. Players have a duty of care to behave in such a way that others may not be injured by their actions. They also have a duty of care to ensure that they do not injure themselves.

All players play at their own risk and should do nothing to jeopardise the safety of themselves or others. If the Course Manager deems the courses unplayable you must obey this notice.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On Course Guidelines

- Please play quickly, quietly and courteously.
- Do not stand close to other players when they are swinging the club
- Always stand behind a player taking the shot
- Do not play until the gap in front is clear
- Shout “fore” if you feel your ball is heading towards other players.
